Day 4: 30 August 2016: **Ankarafantsika**

Great discoveries! The Big Lavaka, which is the result of thousands of years of erosion giving rise to an immense and magnificent colourful canyon which you will find hard to resist photographing. You can also enjoy the baobab trees Adansonia madagascariensis, unique to Madagascar, as are many of the local plant and animal species. Day 5: 31 August 2016: Ankarafantsika - Majunga

After breakfast, you leave Ankarafantsika National Park and drive to Majunga. You will arrive at Majunga about midday when you can begin to discover this city on a guided tour. When the city tour is over, you return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6: 1st September 2016: Majunga

A major scientific event will occur on 1st September 2016 - an annular solar eclipse which will move from west to east from the Atlantic up to the Indian Ocean, and will be visible from the island of Madagascar! For this, you should be ready for viewing with your solar eclipse glasses (supplied), with this event passing overhead from 08:00 am until 10:30 am.

Later, in the afternoon, you will visit the Red Circus which is near the Amborovy beach. For the appreciation of a real tropical sunset this is the place to be. The Cirque Rouge (Red Circus) is a multicoloured circular rock formation that recalls somehow the red coloured American canyons. Right after leaving the beach, you will be suddenly surrounded by hillocks where large gullies have been carved. Erosion has made the sandstone surface display a wide range of colours, from white, pink, orange to ochre shades. Women from the nearby Amborovy village usually come here to collect some of the colourful sand for filling bottles, which are sold to tourists. As already mentioned, the setting is absolutely fabulous when the sun's rays at twilight, hit the cirque, bringing out the natural, vibrant colours of the sand. After this visit, you'll return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Overnight: Antsanitia Resort (B/D)

Day 7: 2nd September 2016: Majunga to Antananarivo

After breakfast, your guide driver accompanies you to Majunga airport for your transfer. When the airport check-in is completed, your guide driver will return to Antananarivo by road. This will be the driver from the hotel Le Relais Des Plateaux who greeted you at the airport.
